

To Hibbing Water Customers

PLEASE CLIP AND SAVE

Starting Monday, June 1, 2020, the Hibbing Public Utilities Commission will begin its Hydrant Inspection and Flushing Program. Flushing is scheduled between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

In the event that it is necessary to use potable water during this time period, we suggest drawing a supply of water for storage, prior to the start of the flushing procedure. Water discoloration may occur temporarily, which can produce iron staining while washing clothes. If possible, refrain from washing clothing during the flushing schedule if you are near the flushing areas below.

The following areas will be flushed from Monday morning, June 1, through Friday afternoon June 5, 2020. Depending on progress these areas may fluctuate, therefore, this schedule may move forward or back a day or more. Areas adjacent or near flushing sites may be affected.

Monday, June 1

- First Avenue (13th St. to Howard St.)
- Park Addition
- Western Addition (Grant St.)

Tuesday, June 2

- First Avenue (Howard St. to 39th St.)

Wednesday, June 3

- First Ave. (39th St. to Townline Rd.)
- West Townline

Thursday, June 4

- West Townline Rd
- Bunker Rd.

Friday, June 5

- East Townline Rd.
- O'Rourke Rd.
- River Creek
