

25 Energy Saving Tips

ELECTRIC CONSUMPTION

1. Install CFL bulbs on frequently used light fixtures and lamps.
2. During hot months, set A/C to 80 degrees or above.
3. Unplug unused kitchen appliances and computers.
4. In the summer, keep shades/curtains down to help keep your house cooler.
5. Plant shade trees on the SW side of your home to help with shade.
6. Install and use ceiling fans in the summer to help cool your home.
7. Use natural light whenever possible instead of turning lights on.
8. Use solar products whenever possible.
9. When boiling water, keep the lid on the pot to prevent heat loss.

*** #9 Applies to gas stoves as well

WATER CONSUMPTION

1. Avoid all outdoor watering if possible, including your lawn.
2. Limit the number of times you flush the toilet.
3. Cut back on the number of times you shower.
4. When showering, turn off water, or set to trickle when soaping.
5. Collect rain water to use for outdoor plants.
6. Keep old fish tank water to use on indoor houseplants.
7. Always run the dishwasher and washing machine with a full load.
8. Install aerating, low-flow faucets and shower heads to limit water usage.
9. Always take a shower instead of a bath if possible.

GAS CONSUMPTION

1. Set your water heater at 120 degrees.
*** #1 Applies to electric hot water heaters as well
2. In the winter, set the thermostat at 68 or less when you are home & awake.
3. In the winter, set the thermostat at 62 or less when you are asleep or away.
4. Close vents and shut doors to rooms that are rarely used.
5. Open curtains and shades on sunny winter days to help warm your home.
6. Use cold water whenever possible.
7. Replace furnace filters often!!
